Ideas of how to distribute the survey: Social media advertising, promoting on Facebook and existing websites, contacting DOH (focus on birth – 5 y/o dads), contacting community colleges w/early childhood education programs and daycare, dads groups, using email lists already used by other agencies and groups and contacting moms since they talk to dads about connecting to resources.
