A Case Opens...

- A Parent or Caretaker Applies for Services
- Court Order is Filed in WA with Pay to the "Washington State Support Registry"
- As a "Matter of Law" from a Public Assistance Program Referral





Parentage, the Starting Point

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

DNA & Biology may not matter

Transforming Lives

- Legal Process to determine the Parents
 - Marriage Presumption
 - Registered Partnership
 - Paternity Acknowledgment
 - Court Order



Why Parentage Matters

- Complete Medical History
- Dependent Benefits
- Life Insurance and Inheritance
- Financial Support
- Medical Support
- Emotional Health and Personal Identity





Legal Obligations and Support Orders

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Administrative Orders

- Can require Financial and/or Medical Support
- Can address child care

Court Orders

- Almost anything goes if a Judge agrees
- Can require Financial and/or Medical Support
- Can require In-Kind Support
 - Usually only Tribal Courts
- Can address child care, school costs, extracurricular activities, claiming the child on your taxes, secondary support, and similar things



Custody & Visitation

- Child Support is Separate from Custody and Visitation
- The Division of Child Support cannot address or enforce anything regarding Custody and Visitation
- The Division of Child Support can provide resources to assist





Changing a Support Order

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Modification

- Anyone can request a modification at any time
 - Not every court or jurisdiction will always do a modification
- Jurisdiction
 - Location of the Order
 - Location of the Parties
- Modifications can be unpredictable

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Goal of Enforcement

- Regular Child Support Payments
- Heath Insurance and access to Healthcare

It's Automatic

- Wage Withholdings
- Filing Liens
- Debt Registry
- Credit Bureau Reporting (>\$1000.00)
- Lottery Winnings (>\$600)



It's Standard

- Referral to an Appropriate Jurisdiction
- WA Issued License Suspension
- Bank Account Collections
- Vehicle Lien and Seizure
- Contempt of Court
- IRS Refunds

- Pay your Child Support
- Keep your info up to date

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



What is it?

- Administrative Review Process
- Administrative Complaint / Grievance Process



What can it do?

- Review Enforcement Actions
- Decide "He Said" / "She Said" Issues
- Respond to any complaint not resolved by an Support Enforcement Officer or their supervisor



What's a "Write-Off"?

- A write-off forgives or eliminates debt
 - ONLY for debt owed to Washington
- A Conference Board Chairperson considers
 - Is the debt appropriate?
 - Is there a hardship to repayment?
 - What is the collection potential?
 - Has other child support debt been forgiven in the past?




Alternative Solutions

- 8,693 Parent Referrals
- 76% of engaged parents removed barriers
- 649 found employment
- 848 Modifications initiated
- 43,104 Resources provided
- \$4,753,026 in debt reduction

Who is eligible?

Must have an open Child Support Case in WA

Must be paying parent (NCP)

Must live in WA State

Willingness to participate

Must be facing barriers outside of child support

Established Communication Method

Instances we would not open full case:


Incarcerated parents < 30 days from release

Parents who are in inpatient treatment < 30 days

Parents living outside of WA



Referring to Alternative Solutions




Parent Self-Referral
